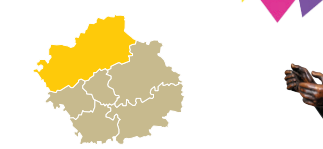

As an already precursor in the launch of an environmental information system of the tourist accommodations and certified ISO 20121 in the responsible management of its events, with a third of its hotels affiliated with, Aube en Champagne continues its process as an innovative responsible destination by the signature of 'Passport vert' supported by UN environment.
