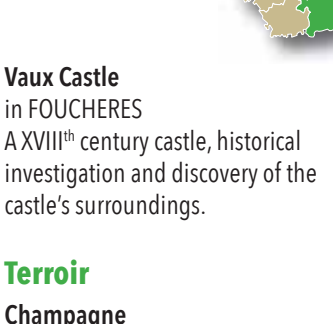

A large collection of porcelain headed dolls from 1850 to 1950, cooper's workshop, 1900 wedding scene, washer women, dairy of yesteryear, milliner's shop.



**CAMILLE CLAUDEL MUSEUM**  
Opening in March 2017 of the first museum dedicated to the international artist, Camille Claudel. Important collection of sculptures of the artist and of Paul Dubois, Alfred Boucher or even the painter Boeschwillwald.



**CHAOURCE CHEESE**  
Chaource, a cheese with a Protected Designation of Origin, has withstood the passing centuries thanks to a cheese tradition rooted in its terroir.



**BLU PLATEAU**  
A magnificent viewpoint overlooking the Champagne vineyard with a viewpoint indicator and picnic area.



**NIGLOLAND**  
in Dolancourt  
France's 3rd amusement park in a remarkable country setting.



**CYCLING ROUTES**

From the Renoir exhibition area to the heart of the intimacy of the artist's Studio, including the familial house opening to the public in 2017, explore this internationally recognized artist's work and life.

**HENRI IV'S HOUSE**  
in Nogent-sur-Seine  
According to legend, this dwelling was the location for the more or less secret love affair between Henri IV and the beautiful Gabrielle d'Estree.



**PAYS D'OTHE CIDER**  
Made from a dozen different varieties of apple, Pays d'Othe cider has a full-fruit and sharp flavour.



**THE TEMPLARS IN AUBE**  
Aube is the birth place of Templar history. The Avallier commandery, Clairvaux Cistercian Abbey or Hugues de Payns museum are many places where you can discover and understand the origins of this famous order.



**MARNAY-SUR-SEINE BOTANICAL GARDEN**  
A real living museum of plants and a remarkable biodiversity conservation area with over 3,000 different plant species in an area of approximately 4,000 m².
